To make your own set of Resurrection Eggs gather 12 plastic eggs and an empty egg carton. Put a token to represent each of the following items inside each egg to tell the Easter story.

Palm Leaf - People waved them and laid them in the streets when Jesus entered Jerusalem riding a donkey. Matthew 21:1-11

Tiny bottle of perfume/cotton ball soaked in perfume - Mary poured perfume on Jesus' feet. John 12:2-8

Bread - Jesus broke bread and shared it with his disciples at the last supper Matthew 26:17-19, 26

3 pieces of silver - Judas betrays Jesus. Matthew 26:14-15 Matthew 27:3

Cross - Jesus carries his cross to the site of the crucifixion. John 19:17

Crown of Thorns - Jesus crowned king of the Jews. John 19:2-4 and Mark 15:17
Dice - Soldiers divide up Jesus' clothes. John 19:23

Nail - Jesus was nailed to the cross. John 19:18, 37 and John 20:25-29

Sponge - They give Jesus a sponge soaked in vinegar to drink. John 19:28-30 and John 20:25

Spices (whole cloves) - Jesus' body is prepared for burial. John 19:40
Stone - They covered Jesus' tomb with a great stone and it was rolled away when Jesus rose. Matthew 27:59-60 and John 20:1

Empty - The tomb was empty. HE HAS RISEN! Matthew 28:6
